Citing a web page is very similar to citing a website except the title of the page is added in italics: Author surname(s), initial(s). (Year of publishing). Title of page [Online]. Title of site. Available at: URL (Accessed: day month year) Web Page Example. Thomson, M. (2017). APA citation [Online]. How and when to reference.

### How to Cite a Website - APA, MLA & Harvard - Mendeley

If you cite more than one work by an author, include a shortened title for the particular work from which you are quoting to distinguish it from the others. Put short titles of books in italics and short titles of articles in quotation marks. Citing two articles by the same author:

Begin with the last name (s) and initial (s) of the author (s). This is followed by the year of publication in parentheses. The article name comes next, followed by the title of the journal (in italics), volume number (in italics) and issue number in parentheses. End with the page numbers.

### How to Write the Article Title Within the Paper | Pen and ...

According to the Chicago Manual of Style and the Modern Language Association, titles of books (and other complete works, such as newspapers and magazines), should be italicized. So if abiding by either of those guides, you'd italicize Stephen King's *The Shining*, just as you would *Vanity Fair* and *The Miami Herald* (and *Appetite for Destruction*, if your protagonist is a Guns N' Roses fan).

### Do You Underline Book Titles? Italicize? Put inside Quote ...

Barring any overriding style guides used for a specific organization or school, the general rule is to use quotations for song titles and italicize CD or album titles. Do not use underlining (in place of italics) unless you're using a typewriter or writing titles by hand. Atomic Imagery / Getty Images.

### Proper Formatting of Song Titles in Written Documents

This citation format differs from others you may be used to because, rather than citing directly to the source you used, you cite to the official record of the bill itself. The in-text citation is similar to those for other APA sources, except that you use the title of the act rather than the name of an author.

A citation to a statute in the United States Code generally contains the following four elements: Title number. U.S.C. (the abbreviation for United States Code in Table 1) Section number preceded by the section symbol (§) and a space. Year of the code\*.

### How to Cite a Journal Article in APA Style | Format & Examples

Cite a federal statute in APA style in the reference list of your work by citing the name of the Act, §, the section number of the Act, the volume number of the U.S. Code, the § and the section number of the U.S. Code, followed by the year of passage in parentheses.

Write The Title of a Book in an Essay Properly. Write the title of a book in an essay due to the general standards and rules of writing. Italics, double quotation marks, and capitalization. Choose wisely.

### Write The Title of a Book in an Essay Properly

When writing out titles for books, articles, chapters, or other non-periodical sources, only capitalize the first word of the title and the first word of the subtitle. Names of people, places, organizations, and other proper nouns also have the first letter capitalized. For books and reports, italicize the title in the APA citation. Examples:

### **Citing a Book in APA | Citation Machine**

No author. Use title in place of author. No date. Use "n.d." ("no date") in place of year. No title. Describe the source in brackets. No author or date. Combine no author and no date. No author or title.
