You may analyze the language in newspapers as part of an assignment for a class or as a way to improve your own news-writing skills. Start by looking at the headline of the news article. You can then examine the body of the article to better understand newspaper language, focusing on structure, tense, voice, rhetoric, and tone.

Analyze whether or not the article communicates values, ethics or ideas that may not be obvious at first. Continue to read and analyze the rest of the newspaper using this method. Figure out if other articles and feature stories are written in a similar format within the newspaper.

Much more important to analyse purpose and think of the articles on a level beyond simply isolated incidences of language. The author's contention and arguments as well as an active audience's response should really be the crux of the essay, leading on to then understanding the role of language in persuasion.

Prompts and Sample Language Analysis Articles

Written language analysis means that you are analysing the reasons writers have chosen specific words and how the writer expects the audience to react. You must not paraphrase (repeat in your own words) what the author has said. The basic "DEER" steps. identify:
